

SCRUBBING

1. Assemble all equipment, chemicals and custodial hardware prior to beginning procedures. Read safety instruction on MSDSs and chemical product labels and comply as directed.
2. Move all moveable objects from area(s) to be scrubbed.
3. Dust Mop floor with a synthetic untreated dust mop to remove loose soil. Use scrapper to remove gum, etc. Dispose of litter.
4. Place Wet Floor Signs at access area(s) to foot traffic.
5. Pre-clean base boards if necessary.
6. Mix ES84 with cold water in a clean bucket with wringer.
7. Apply scrubbing solution liberally to manageable area of floor with a clean, dedicated wash mop. If using auto scrubber, scrub on solution with a red pad or possibly, a blue scrub pad. Do not pick up solution on first pass. Do not allow dry back. Re-wet floor if scrubbing solution begins to dry before final pick up procedure.
8. Allow scrubbing solution 3 to 5 minutes dwell time.
9. Scrub floor with 175-RPM rotary floor machine and red pad or possibly, a blue scrub pad. If using an auto scrubber, this function has been completed.
10. Pick up scrubbing solution with a wet-pickup vacuum or is using auto scrubber, re-scrub, picking up solution on second pass.
11. Damp mop/rinse floor with clean water using a clean, dedicated, rinse mop.
